



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

Purpose of the Visit

Students gained valuable insights into:

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
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- The operational workflow of a medicine wholesaler.

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

- What is cGMP?**

- Why cGMP is Important**

cGMP ensures that medicines are made in a clean, controlled environment and are free from errors or contamination.

- Regulatory Bodies**

He explained how Indian laws (like Schedule M) and international regulations (like US FDA, WHO GMP) are followed by companies.

- **Facilities and Equipment**

Dr. Shivpuje talked about the importance of proper equipment, clean rooms, water systems, and HVAC systems in a manufacturing plant.

- **Role of People**
